

EVROPA U SVETU

EEZ je od početka bila otvorena za **NOVE ČLANICE**.

Postepeno je postajala privilegovani partner **ZEMALJA U RAZVOJU** i vodeći akter u oblasti **MEDUNARODNE TRGOVINE**.

Od podrške demokratskoj tranziciji u Grčkoj, Španiji i Portugaliji sedamdesetih godina prošlog veka do širenja članstva i na demokratske režime u Centralnoj i Istočnoj Evropi po završetku Hladnog rata, proširenje EEZ/EU doprinosilo je održanju mira na Evropskom kontinentu. EU je 2012. dobila **NOBELOVU NAGRADU ZA MIR** zbog doprinosa miru, pomirenju, demokratizaciji i ljudskim pravima u Evropi.

Proces proširenja odvijao se paralelno sa jačanjem međunarodnih aktivnosti EEZ/EU. Zahvaljujući sporazumima zaključenim u **JAUNDEU, LOMEU I KOTONUU** između 1963.

i 2000, EU je postala jedan od vodećih globalnih aktera u oblasti saradnje i razvoja. Od 1960-ih, koristeći **ZAJEDNIČKU TRGOVINSKU POLITIKU** kao osnovu, EEZ/EU je potpisivala direktnе trgovinske sporazume sa trećim zemljama i

učestvovala u međunarodnim trgovinskim pregovorima. U oblasti spoljne politike, od 1970-ih Evropa je težila da govori „jednim glasom“. Po završetku Hladnog rata ovu ambiciju je pojačao neuspeh evropske diplomacije da razreši krizu u Jugoslaviji tokom 1990-ih.

Cilj uvođenja **ZAJEDNIČKE SPOLJNE I BEZBEDNOSNE POLITIKE** (1992) i **ZAJEDNIČKE BEZBEDNOSNE I ODBRAMBENE POLITIKE** (1999) bio je da pojača kolektivnu bezbednost država članica tako što će jačati vladavinu prava i poštovanje ljudskih prava izvan granica EU i što će pomagati u sprečavanju međunarodnih sukoba delajući na osnovu zajedničkih strateških interesa sa međunarodnim organizacijama kao što su **UJEDINJENE NACIJE** i

SEVEROATLANTSKI SAVEZ (NATO). **LISABONSKIM UGOVOROM** stvorena evropska diplomatska služba (**EVROPSKA SLUŽBA ZA SPOLJNE POSLOVE**) jeste rezultat decenijskog napora da se EU transformiše u jedinstvenog aktera na međunarodnom planu.

On the occasion of the first meeting of the Commission and its public service on January 22 and 23, the Commission of the European Communities and its public service will hold a second Dejton Conference on Bosnia and Herzegovina. This meeting will mark the beginning of the implementation of the Commission's essential role in the reconstruction of Bosnia and Herzegovina. It will be organized by the Commission Office in Sarajevo, with the World Bank as well as with other donors including the Monitor of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Special Fund for Bosnia and Herzegovina, the World Bank, temporary agents, and supporting commercial experts.

The Commission will also prepare for the implementation of possible future rehabilitation and reconstruction programmes.

On arrival of the Commission special envoy and staff will immediately start contact with the World Bank, the UNDP, the UNHCR, the OSCE, the World Bank, the World Bank, and other international organizations. Close cooperation with the World Bank and the work of its public service

will be essential in order to ensure that the assistance provided by the World Bank and the public service can be used effectively to support the reconstruction of the country.

It has been agreed to hold a second Dejton Conference on Bosnia and Herzegovina in order to consider the possibility of concluding a framework agreement for the reconstruction of the country.

As for the Commission, it is envisaged that it plays a leading role in this next phase at the local level, particularly in the reconstruction of the most devastated areas. The financial contributions from the World Bank will be for a longer period than the amount of 1 billion ECU (the UNDP 100 million and the OSCE 100 million).
